For Fall 2019 and January 2020 courses: The nomination may be submitted by either the student or the instructor. The submission must include the original graded copy of each essay submission before it will be eligible for consideration for a writing prize. The written endorsement of the instructor is not required, but will be viewed by the Jury as an asset to any submission.

For Winter 2020 courses: The nomination must include the instructor's endorsement of the paper as "exceptional" to the point of "prize-worthy" and either the graded paper or the student's originally submitted copy (in Word or pdf).
